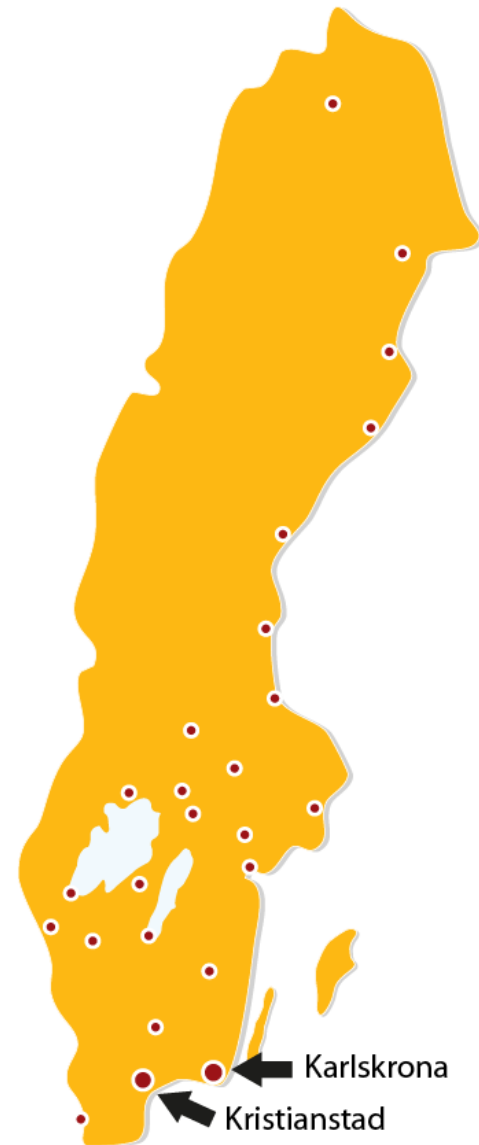

25 reception offices in Sweden



The reception system – April, 2013

- 40 990 people registered in the reception system
- ...whereof 23 500 people registered in accommodations provided by the Migration Board
- Total of 28 100 accommodations
-whereof aprox 6000 are temporary accommodations

Reception office of Kristianstad/Karlskrona



Reception offices in Kristianstad/Karlskrona...

- ...provide accommodations for 1800 people in ordinary apartments
- ...have aprox 300 people registered that stay with a friend or family
- ...provide temporary accommodations for aprox 750 people at three holiday villages
-is operated by 53 staff members

First period as an asylumseeker

- **Accommodation information – at arrival**
- **Children are registered at school**
- **Health examination at health center**
- **Information about migrationprocess and rights/obligations – standardized**
- **Interview/screening meeting at the reception office – within a month from application**
- **Attention and information to children in the asylumprocess**

The future need of temporary accommodation

- number of asylum seekers
- number of asylum seekers choosing accommodation provided by the Migration Board
- number of new ordinary apartment contracts—scarcity of apartments in Sweden
- level of turnover in the reception system
