1. GENERAL INFORMATION

EMN Sweden is pleased to invite you to the EMN Swedish Presidency Conference 2023 on Displacement and migration related to disasters, climate change and environmental degradation, which will take place in Stockholm, Sweden on 11-12 May 2023.

The conference is organised in connection to the Swedish Presidency of the Council of the European Union and will gather EMN National Contact Points, EMN Steering Board Members, policy makers from EMN Member and Observer Countries as well as other countries, EU agencies, NGOs, international organisations and academia. The conference will provide an opportunity for participants to interact and exchange knowledge and experiences in the field of migration related to climate change.

Münchenbryggeriet is centrally located in Södermalm in Stockholm. The venue is about 10 minutes walking distance from the public transport hub Slussen. The closest subway station is Mariatorget on the red line, chose the exit Torkel Knutssongatan and Polishuset. When exiting the subway station, turn right and follow Torkel Knutssongatan approximately 400 meters.

We recommend that you arrive in Stockholm on the 10^{th} of May since the conference starts in the morning at 09:00 on the 11^{th} of May.

3. REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

Registration for the conference is mandatory. Registered participants will receive accreditation badges from the organiser at the event location, Münchenbryggeriet, on the 11th of May from 9.00 in the morning. Please arrive in time to allow for registration as the conference starts at 10.00 the first day and at 9.00 the second day of the conference. Coffee and sandwich will be served in connection to the registration.

All accreditation badges are personal and non-transferable. The badges must be worn visibly by the attendees throughout the conference. Should you lose your badge, please inform the conference organisers.

4. TRANSPORTATION

TRANSPORTATION FROM ARLANDA AIRPORT

The fastest transportation from Arlanda Airport to the Central City station of Stockholm (Stockholm C) is Arlanda Express. The price for a one way ticket is 320 SEK (600 SEK for a return ticket) and the trip takes 18 minutes. Find more information about <u>Arlanda Express</u> <u>here</u>.

Buses are also operating from the airport to the city centre (45 minutes ride). The Vybus4 is operating daily outside terminal 4 and terminal 2/3. Tickets can be purchased online, through the app Vybus4, via the ticket machines at the airport or over the information desk at the Arlanda Airport. One way ticket is about 149 SEK. The bus makes stop in several places in the city, for example Hornstull and Fridhemsplan. Depending on where your hotel is located, the bus might have a stop close by. If you prefer to take a taxi we recommend Taxi Stockholm (phone number +46 15 00 00 or book online at Booking - Taxi Stockholm). You can also find a taxi service at the Arlanda airport. The price is about 795 SEK (71 euro) to the Central City station of Stockholm (Stockholm C) and it is a 50 minutes ride. We recommend that you pay the taxi with a credit or debit card.

STOCKHOLM LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT (SL)

Stockholm has a good and accessible public transportation system with buses, metro, trams and commuter ferries. All information about times and routes can be found on the SL website or in the SL app. You can find information in English on the <u>SL website</u>.

To travel around Stockholm with the public transport you can buy SL travel cards that are valid for 24 or 72 hours, or single journey tickets that are valid for 75 minutes from SL Customer Service Centres and ticket agents (Pressbyrån). Almost all tickets can be bought and stored in the SL App in your mobile phone. You can also travel with SL public transport by tapping a valid contactless card directly on one of SL card readers at the automatic barriers in the metro, at the commuter train stations, on board of the buses or the card

readers on poles placed on tram and light railway stops as well as at some commuter ferry stops. A single journey ticket is 54 SEK. The contactless card must be connected to one of the following card networks: Mastercard, Visa or American Express. There is no touch out in the SL system.

5. DINNER AND VISIT TO MODERNA MUSEET

In the evening of 11 May we are delighted to invite you to a social gathering and dinner at Moderna Museet, located on Skeppsholmen. Moderna Museet is one of Europe's leading museums for modern and contemporary art. The museum collects and exhibits modern art from the early 20th century and photography from 1840 and onwards.

TIMES FOR THE EVENING 11 MAY

- 18.30 Museum opens exclusively for participants in the EMN Swedish Presidency Conference.
- 18.30–19.30 The museum collection is open exclusively for conference participants.
- 19.30 Doors to restaurant open, museum collection closes.
- 20.00 Dinner in the restaurant at Moderna Museet.
- 23.00 Museum and restaurant close.

Please note that registration for the museum visit and dinner is mandatory (registrations were made in connection to the registration for the conference).

TRANSPORT TO MODERNA MUSEET

Moderna Museet is located on an island in central Stockholm. The visiting address is Exercisplan 4, Skeppsholmen.

If you feel like walking to the Moderna Museet it will take around 30 minutes from Münchenbryggeriet and you can view parts of the old town, the royal palace and the beautiful national museum building on the way. After crossing the bridge to Skeppsholmen, continue up the hill. The entrance to Moderna Museet is on the left-hand side.

If you prefer you can also go by boat to Moderna Museet. The boat leaves from Skeppsbron, near Slussen, and the trip takes around five minutes. You need to notify the crew that you wish to disembark at Skeppsholmen when boarding the commuter ferry. This also applies if you would like to go back by boat, press the button on the post at the jetty to notify the crew. To arrive at Skeppsholmen you need to embark the commuter ferry line 82 at Slussen, not too far away from Münchenbryggeriet where the conference takes place.

Participants are expected to arrange with their own transport to the venue and to the hotel after dinner. However do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.
