## A look back at the French chairmanship of the PDD 2019-2020


### <u>Priorities</u>:

- Strengthen partnerships with development and humanitarian actors, and especially help fostering synergies between the different UN agencies in the implementation of mobility and climate programs.
- Better involve the PDD in regional processes, especially in Africa.
- Mobilize further states and to reinforce their connection with the civil society partners.

French mandate notably resulted in concrete support to operational actions by IOM and UNHCR in West Africa/Sahel and Central America.



## 2022-2023 French Chairmanship of the Global Forum on Migration and Development (GFMD)



#### 6 priorities:

- 1. The impact of climate change on human mobility: preventive action, humanitarian action and development;
- 2. Rights and migration: working to ensure the health, safety and rights of migrants;
- 3. Diasporas: actors of economic, social and cultural development of regions;
- 4. Labour migration: promoting the economic inclusion of migrants;
- 5. Improving the perception of migration in public opinion through narratives, culture, emotion and rational discourse;
- 6. Multi-level governance: bringing together the various stakeholders for improved migration management,
